

Singing with the harp

Saturday 3rd July or Saturday 17th July

Who is the day for?

The day is for any harpist of grade 3-5+ standard who would like to develop in their ability to sing and play the harp at the same time. No previous experience of singing with the harp is necessary to attend the course, but you will need to be comfortable singing in a small group of 6 - no solos!

What will the course cover?

The day will run from 10am (coffee from 9.30am) to 4pm and will cover:

Session One: Combined voice & harp warm-ups, basic harmony and lead sheets.

Session Two: Accompaniment ideas to learn, try and take-away.

Session Three: Ensembles pieces to learn and play together.

Session Four: Individual practice space.

Session Five: Bringing it all together

What is the cost and what is included?

The cost of the day is £200 (£100 payable on booking as a non-refundable deposit and the balance due a week before the course.) There are only 6 places available on each day and 4 students are required for the course to run. (A full refund will be given if necessary.) The course is supported by a comprehensive booklet which means you will leave with lots of ideas to develop your skills further.

Refreshments are included: tea, coffee, soft drinks and a sandwich lunch.

You will need to bring your own harp (lever or pedal) and a music stand. Your harp must be fully insured against any damage.

Lucy is available on 4th & 18th July for individual lessons of 45 minutes for an additional charge of £50.

Where is the course?

The Moorings is a riverside house in Chesterton, Cambridge. 'Singing with the harp' will run in the Studio in the garden. It is an idyllic spot and the studio is a creative place having been used for many years by a local artist. There is parking for 6 cars.
